

IMPACT REPORT

JULY - AUGUST 2022



During this two month period, we have fed...

2,052

(as of 22/08/2022) individual BwD residents and we have gone out in the van to distribute to different communities that cannot get to us.

These include Darwen Valley Community Centre, Audley Community Centre, Ash Grove Centre, Albion Mill and Sacred Heart and St Edwards Parish Hall. In addition, we have also delivered food to CVS, WISH and Humraaz.

This young fella was delighted with his red apple when we distributed food at Sacred Heart and St Edwards

Parish Hall on Thursday 11 August.

We distributed 47 family portions and 30 small portions feeding and supporting 237 residents in just one afternoon!

We have collected and distributed the equivalent of the following meals during this period:

1098 meals from Lidl stores for July and August

270 £6 food boxes distributed during July and August

These specific food boxes help people to budget by paying for their food this week and collecting the following week.

876 BWD funded Food Boxes distributed to families in Blackburn with Darwen.
