We were able to share lots of surplus stock with the Foodbank and our friends at the Highercroft Local Conversation Group.

The kind donation went a long way in supporting lots of families and individuals in need across Blackburn with






In partnership with BwD Council, over the past two months we have supported **273** local families.

Heavily subsidised food boxes are available for any resident of Blackburn or Darwen to purchase, supporting our community through the energy and cost of living crisis, at a time when it is needed more than ever.

Over 200 bottles of suncream, kindly donated to us by Tesco, allowed us to share a surplus of 60 bottles to local charity, Spark. Spark is a specialist drug and alcohol service supporting health, housing and community groups locally.





Our Tuesday foodboxes are often supplemented with extra donations received from our donors.

In May, our friends and supporters at Primeline Sales, donated a large amount of surface cleaner, toilet cleaner and bleach that further allowed us to support the local community.

We also included FREE hygiene packs including toilet tissue and body spray, kindly donated by our member Granby Marketing, with every subsidised food box purchase.





During May and June, we have supported 180 families with this food project, even supporting them with budgeting skills by allowing them to pay for their portions in advance

Special thanks to Fagan & Whalley and Vodafone for helping with logistics of these donations.

The value of the food boxes far outweighs the £6 cost. This helps to make household finances spread much further during these uncertain times.

She then makes sandwiches and shares them out to the homeless the very same evening.

Donna loves helping those in need and has been supporting the homeless community for over two years with CBP surplus foods.

We collected an impressive 112 tins and packets of food!

Reclaiming paint stops perfectly good materials from reaching landfill and reduces the amount of Co2 emissions emitted.

Every litre of reclaimed paint saves 2.7kg of CO2!

We have recently distributed 1351 litres of paint which is the equivalent of 3,647.70kg of CO2!

This also enables local residents to improve their living space in a cost-effective way, promoting a higher sense of well-being.

Recently we have supported 167 individuals to purchase low-cost paint.

1 litre of paint = 2.7kg CO2



We received a 'dead stock' donation from Robert Scott & sons in Burnley.

They donated items that had been on their warehouse racking for over 10 years.

The boxes were thick with black dust but there were treasures inside!

With their permission, we put together some car cleaning kits and sold them as a perfect Fathers Day gift.

As with all of our income generating ideas, all money made goes back into the organisation to support our community.
